Item 1 is held by Anglian Water and has been provided as an attachment.

The data provided within the event list summary, is an extract of the Environment Agency’s National Incident Recording System (NIRS). The Environment Agency are responsible for the recording and classification of pollution incidents in line with the Common Incident Classification Scheme.

The extract covers incidents recorded between 1 January 2021 and 31 December 2025 that are geographically associated with the River Granta, Cambridgeshire, between Bartlow and Great Abington. This includes incidents linked to the following assets:

- Linton Sewage Treatment Works (STW) – *LINTST*
- Pumping stations within Linton:
 - Linton Farm Transfer Pumping Station – *LINLSM*
 - Linton Recreation Ground Transfer Pumping Station – *LINRSM*
 - Linton Emerson Close Pumping Station – *LINESP*

The spreadsheet contains a list of discharges to the environment which have had a category 3 (minor) and above impact. Please note events occurring in 2025 have not yet been verified or confirmed by the Environment Agency. Given the source data is from the Environment Agency you may wish to seek additional information regarding the assessed environmental impact from them directly.

For the events we have provided the full incident timeline along with any further investigation work which was carried out.

We have also undertaken searches for any relevant correspondence held by email. No such correspondence has been identified. This is likely because all operational correspondence and records relating to pollution incidents are logged and managed through our internal Pollution Control Centre (PCC) system rather than email.
