Thank you for your request for information about capacity at Ryhall Water Recycling Centre, which we received on 24 July 2025. Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

You requested:

1. Does Ryhall Water Recycling Centre have adequate capacity to accommodate the development being constructed and planned in the area
2. Has an impact assessment of the developments will affect Ryhall Water Recycling Centre
3. When has untreated water been discharged from Ryhall Water Recycling Centre in the past 3 years

**Item 1** is held by Anglian Water and has been provided as an attachment and below.

The Ryhall Water Recycling Centre (WRC) does have headroom availability to accept and treat new foul flows from these new developments. Anglian Water undertook a capacity assessment for the Meadow Lane development in December 2022, and confirmed the Ryhall WRC has capacity to accommodate foul flows from the proposed development. Please find attached our response, AW reference PLN-0159876. PLN-0159876+-+Planning+Report.pdf

Anglian Water are obligated under section 106 of the Water Industry Act to accept connections from sites with planning consent. The Belmesthorpe Lane development has planning consent under reference 2021/1268/FUL. Anglian Water undertook a capacity assessment and provided comment in November 2021. Please find this attached, AW reference PLN-0135740. PLN-0135740+-+Planning+Report.pdf

Both developments are not discharging surface water into the Anglian Water network, therefore this is outside of our jurisdiction for comment.

**Item 2** is held by Anglian Water and has been provided as an attachment and below.

Capacity assessments have been undertaken for both developments as mentioned above and attached.

The proposals are not anticipated to exceed the capability of the WRC.

There is currently no funding allocated at this Water Recycling Centre (WRC) for AMP 8 (2025-2030), however we may seek to promote investment through our future business plans.
