Dear Requester

Thank you for your request for information about Beanfield in Corby, which we received on 28 July 2025. Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

You requested:

- 1.Asset maps showing the location and type of sewer infrastructure (foul, surface water, and combined systems) in the Beanfield area of Corby
- 2.Asset maps for clean water mains of the Beanfield area of Corby
- 3.Records of any sewer flooding or water main bursts in the past 10 years in the Beanfield area of Corby
- 4.Any planned or completed investment or improvement works affecting the drainage or water networks in the area  
Any summary information relating to known capacity issues, surcharge risk, or inflow/infiltration within the local network
- 5.Any standard guidance or materials Anglian Water provides to communities or local councils to support flood preparedness and understanding of sewer/water infrastructure

### **EIR Response: Provision of Requested Information**

**Item 1 & 2** is held by Anglian Water but is reasonably accessible.

Anglian Water provides Public Access Terminals which members of the public can use to access water and sewerage mapping and related asset information.

There are three terminals located at Anglian Water, Henderson House, 4 Lancaster Way, Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire PE29 7DU.

These terminals are available for use between 09:00 and 17:00 hrs, Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays). There is no need to book an appointment, just turn up, park in one of the marked visitor bays and go to Reception to sign in. If the terminals are in use you'll be asked to wait, and in busy times your access may be limited to a specific time period.

Anglian Water Asset Plans are also available online from [Digdat Utilities](#) for a fee.

You may also be able to view Anglian Water Asset plans at your local council offices.

**Flow related investments in AMP7**

2 x new storm tanks at Corby WRC delivered in April 2023. Total volume 2627m3

A scheme to reduce pluvial flood risk at Corby WRC via the construction of flood embankments - completed December 2022

**AMP8 spill improvement**

All storm overflows in the Corby network (Corby Water Recycling Centre, Corby-Studfall Avenue and Weldon-North TPS) will have investigations carried out in this AMP to determine if spills are causing an environmental impact. This information will then be used to prioritise any further investment.

**Item 5** is held by Anglian Water and has been provided below.

Looking at the attached spreadsheet (Beanfield Corby.xlsx) a lot of the sewer flooding in the area was caused by blockages.

Advice on avoiding blockages can be found on our website [Keeping the sewers clear](#) Anglian Water is running a campaign called 'Just Bin it' to remind people to bin wet wipes and sanitary products and to put cooled cooking fat, oil or grease (FOG) into the bin rather than putting down the toilet or sink. The oil and grease left over after cooking actually hardens when it reaches the cool of the sewers and when mixed with things like wipes it can cause blockages more commonly known as fatbergs. Along side the 'Just Bin it' campaign we have been using hedgehog devices to gather data to initiate communications with the public. [Hedgehogs in the sewers: A prickly prod to stop flushing wet wipes!](#)
