Dear LPAs

As promised at our Webinars please find attached the updated list of all our water recycling centres (WRC) by LPA, showing how we will be responding to planning applications in each catchment going forward.

Please note that some WRCs will serve multiple LPAs. Please do not share externally, we are aiming to share with our developer customers after the next webinar at the end of April.

You will note that we have identified those WRCs classified as small sewerage discharge and descriptive works, these are WRCs which serve a small population and are very constrained. We have a position statement regarding these WRCs which can be found on our website: [descriptive-works-position-statement-march-2025.pdf](#)

The calculations which have informed our planning position is the 2024 Dry Weather Flow Q90 verified data sent to the Environment Agency, plus sites with planning consent which we anticipate will be connecting by the end of 2025. These figures only include residential properties. It does not include other use classes, with planning consent, which will add additional flows to the catchments such as offices, shops, schools etc.

When responding to local plans we do calculate WRC headroom in a slightly different way with Q80 DWF 5 year average. We use Q80 over a 5-year period to account for variations owing to particularly dry or wet year weather patterns. This takes account of the long-term view of growth over the plan period which covers multiple asset management periods (AMPs) to allow for future growth investment.

This list will be updated yearly.
